**MONDAY, JUNE 17<sup>m</sup>** - Your morning arrival at Rome Airport will be met for the transfer to our city-center hotel. If our rooms are not available for immediate check-in, there will be time to find lunch and begin exploring the neighborhood. This afternoon we can unpack and rest up from the overnight flight. This evening we will gather for a cocktail reception and dinner at the hotel, with a quick lesson in food and wine pairing. **(D) OVERNIGHT: ROME** 

**TUESDAY, JUNE 18<sup>TH</sup>** - Our first stop this morning is the Cantine Minardi, located just outside of Rome. Here we will have a pasta making class, a tour, a tasting and lunch. This afternoon we drive north to Tuscany and to our hotel in the town of Montalcino. Dinner is included this evening. (B, L, D) **OVERNIGHT: MONTALCINO** 

**WEDNESDAY, JUNE 19<sup>TH</sup>** - Today we have a VIP tour of the Castello Banfi's Italian Flagship winery in neighboring Camigliano. Banfi Vinters is a multinational, family-owned business, founded in New York in 1919. We'll explore Il Borgo (the Banfi Castle), and attend an education session on Italian wines, before touring the facilities. We'll then enjoy a wine tasting and sumptuous lunch in the castle dining room. We return to our hotel in Montalcino this afternoon for a well-earned siesta (a great Italian tradition). The rest of the afternoon and evening are free to explore this beautiful

**THURSDAY, JUNE 20<sup>TH</sup>** - Our excursion today takes us into the heart of Tuscany and the dreamy landscapes that most powerfully evoke romantic Italy. We'll visit Siena for a walking tour of this beautiful medieval city built around the lovely Piazza del Campo. Siena's Duomo is one of the most dramatic in Italy with its striking black and white marble pillars and facade. The inlaid marble floor, featuring Biblical scenes, is an architectural and artistic treasure. Before leaving Siena, we'll visit the house of St. Catherine, patron saint of Siena. It was she who persuaded Gregory XI to return the seat of the papacy to Rome after 67 years of exile in Avignon. We finish our afternoon in Siena with a class titled "Pizza, focaccia & beer," that includes a lunch we prepare ourselves. After we return to Montalcino you will have the evening free. **(B, L) OVERNIGHT: MONTALCINO** 



**FRIDAY, JUNE 21<sup>sr</sup>** - A short drive this morning brings us to the Castle Brolio. Here we will visit the Barone Ricasoli winery—the oldest winery in Italy and the second oldest in the world! This is the birthplace of Chianti Classico. We'll have a tour of the castle and the winery and then have time for lunch, before our afternoon drive to Reggio Emilia. Dinner is included this evening. (**B**, **L**, **D**) **OVERNIGHT: REGGIO EMILIA**

**SATURDAY, JUNE 22<sup>ND</sup>** - Our excursion today takes us to Modena, home of Balsamic Vinegar. Most will be amazed at the difference in taste between what is produced here and what is sold commercially. Traditionally a batch of new balsamic vinegar was only started at the birth of a baby girl and it would become her dowry when she would marry. We will visit an acetaia, where the vinegar is made, to see the process and taste the black gold for ourselves. Later this afternoon, we head to the Albinea Canali winery, where they make the frizzante Lambrusco wines using the traditional method. We'll taste then return to our hotel where we will have time to rest before dinner (**B**, **D**) **OVERNIGHT: REGGIO EMILIA** 

SUNDAY, JUNE 23<sup>RD</sup> - Ever wonder how all that amazing Parmigiano-Reggiano cheese is made? Early this morning we head towards Parma, to an artisanal cheese producer for a tour of their factory, where we learn the craft of cheese making. Afterwards we have a sit-down sampling of not just their cheese, but local honey and balsamic vinegar. We thern continue west, across the Apennine Mountains to the Ligurian Coast and the traditional fishing port of Santa Margherita Ligure, where we will have a free afternoon followed by a group dinner. (B, D) OVERNIGHT: SANTA MARGHERITA LIGURE

**MONDAY, JUNE 24**<sup>TH</sup> - A free day to relax and enjoy the region. Weather permitting, you could take a short boat ride to Portofino or head into the town of Rapallo. (B) **OVERNIGHT: SANTA MARGHERITA LIGURE** 



**TUESDAY, JUNE 25<sup>TH</sup>** - Leaving the Ligurian Coast, we head north, via Genoa, to our hotel in Monforte d'Alba, in the heart of the Barolo and Barbaresco wine regions. On the way, we'll stop in Strevi. Here we will visit the Cantine Banfi Piemonte for a tour, tasting and lunch. Our next stop is in Barbaresco to taste at Marquesi di Gresi, a traditional winery with a Kiwi winemaker! We'll dine together in the Langhe at Ristorante Marc Lanteri. Marc held a Michelin star at his previous restaurant for years; he and his wife Amy (a Coloradan) are excited to have us visit their new outpost. Finally, we'll check in at our hotel in Monforte. (B, D) **OVERNIGHT:** MONFORTE D'ALBA

WEDNESDAY, JUNE 26TH - We begin the day with a visit to a fabulous Barolo producer in Monforte,

Domenico Clerico. From here we drive to Alba to visit an unbelievable truffle grower and distributor, TartufLanghe. In addition to a tour and tasting of the factory (they produce phenomenal truffle products) we'll be having lunch featuring truffle dishes and wine pairings. Return to the hotel following lunch. Dinner is on your own in Monforte **(B, L) OVERNIGHT: MONFORTE D'ALBA** 

THURSDAY, JUNE 27<sup>TH</sup> - A completely free day in Monforte to pursue individual interests - or just rest! (B) OVERNIGHT: MONFORTE D'ALBA

**FRIDAY, JUNE 28<sup>m</sup>** - Today we will taste at two of Monforte's finest wineries. Conterno Fantino is a short walk across the street from our hotel and has the most incredible view of the Alps to go along with fantastic wine. We'll follow that up with a stroll down the street and pizza for lunch. In the afternoon we visit with one of my absolute favorites, Simone Scaletta. After visiting with Simone we will drive to our hotel near Milan Malpensa Airport, where we'll have time to relax and freshen up before gathering for a farewell dinner. (B, L, D) **OVERNIGHT: MALPENSA**

**MONDAY, JUNE 17<sup>m</sup>** - A leisurely day to explore this glorious city on your own. Stroll along the banks of the Tiber, past the Castel Sant'Angelo, linger over lunch in the heart of old Trastevere, toss a coin in the Trevi Fountain, stop for a rosy red Campari in the midst of Piazza Navona's Baroque splendor, explore the Centro Storico (historic center), pausing to savor the languid palms rising above the steps at Piazza di Spagna, or take in the upscale shops lining Via Condotti—the day will slip by before you know it. We'll gather early this evening for a reception to meet the rest of the group arriving today and join them for dinner. **(B, D) OVERNIGHT: ROME**
